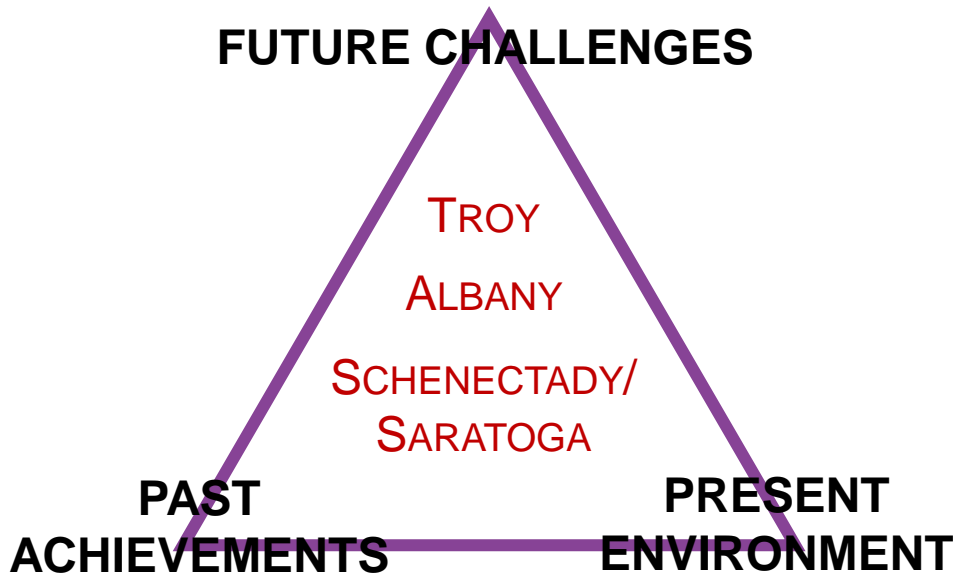

Previous positions include President of Simmons College, Boston, Massachusetts, dean of the School of Public Health at the University of Illinois at Chicago, and associate dean of public health and professor of public health and anthropology at the University of California at Los Angeles. She is a graduate of Barnard College, with a Ph.D. in anthropology from Columbia University. Her research includes community participatory research methods, health disparities, pregnancy outcomes, violence prevention, and culturally appropriate delivery of health care. She is a member of the National Academy of Medicine (NAM) and a fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science and the American Anthropological Association. Her honors include being named the 2014 recipient of the Society for Medical Anthropology's Career Achievement Award, the Margaret Mead Award, and a Hero of Public Health gold medal awarded by President Vicente Fox of Mexico.
